



- 2. **The Latest Trends and Technologies** This workshop will discuss the use of various forms of electronic communication devices through which users create online communities to share information, ideas, personal messages, and other content (i.e., Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, YouTube, LinkedIn, etc.).
